ZDF for ARTE, as well as Persona, a Turkish crime thriller series produced by Ay Yapim for Puhu TV, starring Haluk Bilginer, who received the International Emmy® Award for his performance in the series. Her latest projects include *The Silence*, a series based on the critically acclaimed books that uncovered human and weapons trafficking throughout Eastern Europe produced by Drugi plan and HRT in co-production with Beta Film, Star Media, OLL.TV and ZDF/ARTE, and the Ukrainian series IN HER CAR, produced by Starlight Media and Gaumont in co-production with France Télévisions and ZDF, which will premiere in 2024.
