## The Pilecki Report

Raport Pileckiego


It is the story of a great WW II hero, one of the bravest Poles in history – Captain Witold Pilecki, was, according to many historians, among the most important conspirators of WWII on all fronts. His heroic and sometimes even hopeless fight against the two ruthless totalitarianisms of the 20th century – German and Soviet – is dramatically visible in his biography. The film tells the story of a man whom the communist propaganda tried to erase from the consciousness of Poles and history for nearly 45 years. The viewers can follow the fate of a brave conspirator, a loving husband and father, and a man who voluntarily agreed to be arrested and transported to Auschwitz. Soon after the end of WWII, he finished writing and editing the so-called *The Pilecki Report*, which is an extraordinary testimony to the German crimes in Auschwitz and the activities of the resistance movement in the camp.

### Under the Old Oak Tree

This film is an adaptation of one of Maria Rodziewiczówna's best-known novels of manners. This seven-episode series tells a story about love, honour and family, intertwined with the lives of people from lower and higher social classes whose lives changed after the January Uprising. Marek Czertwan is faced with a new duty imposed on him by his dying father – he has to take additional care of the estate left by his father's lost friend, insurgent magnate Kazimierz Orwid. How will Marek cope with the new situation? Will he succumb to the charms of Irena, the rightful heir to the manor? The ideals of the characters are put to a difficult test, and their desires come into conflict with the duties imposed by their family. Dewajtis, a primeval oak tree, casts its soothing shadow over the heads of those who in its shade are looking for an escape from the hardships of everyday life. The tree becomes a majestic symbol of this intergenerational community.



## 1410, Battle of Grunwald

The most famous battle in Polish history, presented from the points of view of the three of its most important participants: King of Poland Władysław Jagiełło, Grand Duke of Lithuania Vytautas, and Grand Master of the Teutonic Order Ulrich von Jungingen. Their characters are re-enacted by the actors who play the aforementioned roles in the popular series The Crown of the Kings. The Jagiellonians – Sebastian Skoczeń, Michał Chorosiński and Szymon Nygard. They set out from contemporary Kraków, Vilnius and Malbork to meet on the field of the Battle of Grunwald and at the same time bring the viewers closer to the motivations, experiences and feelings of their characters. The film is not merely a documentary with commentary presented by historians on the origins, course and significance of the battle. The creators added fictional depictions, which will bring the viewer into the world of the greatest triumph in the history of the Polish army.

The film combines footage from rehearsals, conversations, dreams, memories, and behind-the-scenes glimpses to create a compelling narrative about Pastor and the art of ballet. Through Pastor's close collaboration with the camera, viewers are granted unprecedented access to the inner workings of the ballet world. They witness the meticulous construction of scenes, the intricate coordination between dancers, and the immense pressure Pastor faces in preparing for a premiere. ### Natural Born Winners

The documentary pictures the Polish men's amp football team and its struggle on the path to European Championship. The cutthroat season filled with uncertainties involving the Coronavirus pandemic leads the players and the coaching staff to the limits of human capacities. The narration focuses on the private lives of selected protagonists, who as a result of their disabilities, fight with each day, breaching their own mental and physical limitations. The players support themselves and their families through professions other than sports, as football brings them no income.

### The City of Wrath

Miasto gniewu

A gripping documentary series about the origins and growth of organized crime in Poland. Each episode depicts a crime committed as a result of a feud between warring gangs. The audience may learn about political changes in the country and how these changes influenced the development of organized crime. The first episode presents the story of the Pruszków Mafia, it also answers the questions of how the gangsters grew in strength, how they earned and in what ways they acted. The viewers may learn how the Polish police looked like at the beginning of the 1990s and whether it was prepared to fight organized crime. In the first season, the creators concentrate on the metropolitan crime underworld. Numerous archival materials of Warsaw Police Department and TVP Polish Public Television have been incorporated into the series.

## Coal's Daughters

Córy węgla

Oliwia, a young woman in her twenties, is persuaded by her mother to start a blue-collar job in the local coalmine. In joining one of the harshest industries, she follows the longstanding family tradition. Aside from its physical demands, the job requires Oliwia to hold her own in a traditionally male environment. Choosing her future path, the young woman is torn between mordernity, represented by her sister, and the tradition Oliwia's mother urges her to keep up. The story centers around Oliwia's dilemma, evoking the impending nature of what is inescapable in her life and the burden of knowing that she may well belong to the last generation working in the coalmine industry. The film is crafted in the style of a novel, with its inevitable sequence of seasons, accompanied by the music of Max Richter. The coalmine and its workers are elevated to the role of the film's secondary protagonist, visually reminiscent of a 19th century setting.
