In 2013, she wrote her debut play, The Idealist, which was produced by her company, Odd Stumble, at the Tara Arts Theatre in London and the Brighton Fringe Festival. Kivinen has extensive expertise in creatively and commercially marketing and selling Finnish stories globally and has built a strong network of clients among major TV and VOD players around the world.

Through his work with the marketing and TV industry agency Mediavision, Ivan has played a key role in the development, programming, and organization of NEM events. Since 2012, he has been involved in all ten editions of NEM Dubrovnik and two of NEM Zagreb, in addition to working with clients from various other industries.

Ivan's most significant project began in 2013 with the launch of Pickbox NOW, the first SVoD service in the Adria region. Presently, pickbox NOW is accessible through desktop, mobile, tablet, and Smart TV applications, as well as through telecom operators in Croatia, Slovenia, Serbia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Montenegro, North Macedonia, and Bulgaria. In 2019, the Pickbox TV channel was introduced and is now available. in these seven countries

Additionally, Ivan manages Mediatranslations, a leading CEE company specializing in subtitling in and out of 30 languages. Wiktor Piatkowski is a writer, producer, and showrunner. He created and co-wrote HBO's first original series produced in Poland, Wataha, and has worked on four Netflix original feature films, including Squared Love. He also developed the first Polish Viaplay series, Murderesses, and the Canal+/Polsat co-production Sortownia. A sitcom he co-created and co-wrote, Just Push Abuba, premiered on ZDF in 2018. His producer credits include feature films like Święta inaczej, as well as short films such as Reset and documentaries including Over the Mountains and Trzej przyjaciele z boiska. Wiktor graduated from the Polish National Film School in Łódź and is an alumnus of several prestigious programs, including Serial Eyes, I European TV Drama Series Lab, European Showrunner Training, Canneseries Writers Club, Racconti, The Owl, and Berlinale Talents. He is a member of SEAN, the Polish Filmmakers Association (SFP). and the Polish Screenwriters' Association. Additionally, Wiktor runs screenwriting workshops both in Poland and internationally, holds a PhD in TV marketing, and manages Bahama Films, an independent production company based in Warsaw.

Feras Fayyad is a two-time Oscar-nominated and Emmy-winning director, producer, writer, and TED speaker. He gained international acclaim for his documentaries Last Men in Aleppo (2017) and The Cave (2019), earning over 120 awards, including the TIFF People's Choice Award and the Sundance Grand Jury Prize, alongside two Academy Award nominations for Best Documentary Feature. Fayyad is the first Syrian director to be nominated for both an Academy Award and the Directors Guild of America Award. He is a two-time Peabody Award winner, often regarded as the equivalent of the Pulitzer Prize, and has also received the Danish Academy Award, known as "The Danish Oscar." He made history as the first non-Danish director to be honored as the most talented director in Denmark. Fayyad has collaborated with leading American and European film studios and networks, including Netflix, Disney, National Geographic, ARTE, PBS, BBC, and ARD. His films have been supported by top film funds in Europe, the UK, and the U.S., such as the Sundance Film Institute, National Geographic, Danish Film Institute, and German Film Fund. He has served on the jury for prestigious film festivals like Zurich, Sundance, Sheffield, and Malmö, and has mentored emerging filmmakers through the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences. Fayyad has conducted masterclasses at institutions such as Columbia University, Munich Film School, and Yale Film School. He is currently directing two fiction films and working on two animations with U.S. and U.K.-based studios.

Karol Piekarczyk is the Artistic Director of Millennium Docs Against Gravity, the largest film festival in Poland. 

Project Synopsis:

People in Chiapas, the poorest state in Mexico, consume the most Coca-Cola in the world - over 2 liters per person per day. Coca-Cola plays a ceremonial role during church prayers, and traditional healers even attribute healing properties to it. Business transactions often involve gifting large quantities of Coca-Cola, and politicians seeking votes are expected to offer up to 180 cases of the drink. However, Chiapas is also grappling with a diabetes epidemic. The Coca-Cola factories are depleting groundwater, leaving local residents deprived of access to drinking water. Ola, a journalist from the Polish crew, teams up with Joel, an indigenous artist from the Mexican crew, to explore why Chiapas has the highest global consumption of Coca-Cola. Throughout their journey, they reflect on the varying responses they receive from interviewees and consider whether these differences are influenced by their backgrounds and skin colors. Will they uncover why Coca-Cola has taken such a hold on the Mexican soul?
